


## CHARLIE FUNK

Charlie Funk is currently President & CEO of MidWest*One* Financial Group, a \$1.7 billion company based in Iowa City. He was President & CEO of Iowa State Bank & Trust Co. in Iowa City from 2001 to 2008. ISB Financial merged with MidWest*One* Financial Group in 2008. MidWest*One* has 25 offices in 19 communities in Eastern and Southeastern Iowa.

He has also served in many community leadership positions in the Iowa City area, including United Way of Johnson County Campaign Chair, Chairman of the Iowa City Area Chamber of Commerce and co-chair of a successful school bond referendum. He served as Chairman of the Iowa Bankers Association 2010-2011 and currently serves on the Board of Directors of the American Bankers Association.

He is a member of the William Jewell College Athletic Hall of Fame and was recently designated as an Achievement Day honoree at William Jewell, the highest honor given to an alumnus.

Charlie has 34 years of banking experience, moving to Iowa City from Des Moines where he was President of Brenton Bank Des Moines and Central Region Manager for Brenton Bank. Prior to that, he was the Chief Investment Officer for Brenton.
