

**AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. GRIMM OF NEW
YORK
TO THE AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. AL GREEN
OF TEXAS
[HR 836]**

Strike the first amendatory instruction and all that follows through the end of the amendatory instruction relating to section 3(b).

Strike line 8 on page 2 of the amendment and all that follows through page 3, line 14, and insert the following new subsection:

1 (d) STUDY OF USE OF PROGRAM BY MEMBERS OF
2 THE ARMED FORCES, VETERANS, AND GOLD STAR RE-
3 CIPIENTS.—

4 (1) STUDY.—The Secretary of Housing and
5 Urban Development shall conduct a study to deter-
6 mine the extent of usage of the Emergency Mort-
7 gage Relief Program authorized under the provisions
8 specified in subsection (a) by, and the impact of
9 such program on, covered homeowners.

10 (2) REPORT.—Not later than the expiration of
11 the 90-day period beginning on the date of the en-

1 actment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
2 the Congress a report setting forth the results of the
3 study under paragraph (1) and identifying best
4 practices, with respect to covered homeowners, that
5 could be applied to the Emergency Mortgage Relief
6 Program.

7 (3) COVERED HOMEOWNER.—For purposes of
8 this subsection, the term “covered homeowner”
9 means a homeowner who is—

10 (A) a member of the Armed Forces of the
11 United States on active duty or the spouse or
12 parent of such a member;

13 (B) a veteran, as such term is defined in
14 section 101 of title 38, United States Code; or

15 (C) eligible to receive a Gold Star lapel pin
16 under section 1126 of title 10, United States
17 Code, as a widow, parent, or next of kin of a
18 member of the Armed Forces person who died
19 in a manner described in subsection (a) of such
20 section.
