

**AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. GRIMM OF NEW  
YORK  
TO THE AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. AL GREEN  
OF TEXAS,  
[HR 839]**

Strike the first amendatory instruction.

Strike line 1 on page 1 of the amendment and all that follows through page 2, line 8, and insert the following new paragraph:

1           “(3) STUDY OF USE OF PROGRAM BY MEMBERS  
2           OF THE ARMED FORCES, VETERANS, AND GOLD  
3           STAR RECIPIENTS.—

4           “(A) STUDY.—The Secretary shall conduct  
5           a study to determine the extent of usage of the  
6           Home Affordable Modification Program by, and  
7           the impact of such Program on, covered home-  
8           owners.

9           “(B) REPORT.—Not later than the expira-  
10          tion of the 90-day period beginning on the date  
11          of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall  
12          submit to the Congress a report setting forth  
13          the results of the study under paragraph (1)

1 and identifying best practices, derived from  
2 studying the Home Affordable Modification  
3 Program, that could be applied to existing  
4 mortgage assistance programs available to cov-  
5 ered homeowners.

6 “(C) COVERED HOMEOWNER.—For pur-  
7 poses of this subsection, the term ‘covered  
8 homeowner’ means a homeowner who is—

9 “(i) a member of the Armed Forces of  
10 the United States on active duty or the  
11 spouse or parent of such a member;

12 “(ii) a veteran, as such term is de-  
13 fined in section 101 of title 38, United  
14 States Code; or

15 “(iii) eligible to receive a Gold Star  
16 lapel pin under section 1126 of title 10,  
17 United States Code, as a widow, parent, or  
18 next of kin of a member of the Armed  
19 Forces person who died in a manner de-  
20 scribed in subsection (a) of such section.”.
