for the 114th Congress

On Wednesday, January 21, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. in room HVC-210 of the House Visitors' Center, the Financial Services Committee will meet to adopt its oversight plan for the 114th Congress.

Rule X of the Rules of the House requires each standing committee, not later than February 15 of the first session, to adopt an oversight plan for the 114th Congress.

The committee print circulated with this memo constitutes the Chairman's proposed oversight plan of the Committee on Financial Services for the 114th Congress. The document includes areas in which the Committee and its subcommittees expect to conduct oversight during this Congress, but is not intended to be an exhaustive list. The plan addresses the laws, programs, and agencies within the Committee's jurisdiction, particularly in the oversight of issues related to financial institutions, capital markets, securities, government sponsored enterprises, housing, insurance, international finance, the economy, domestic monetary policy and technology.
