The Subcommittee on Capital Markets and Government Sponsored Enterprises will hold a hearing entitled “The Impact of Regulations on Short-Term Financing” at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, December 8, 2016, in room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building. This will be a one-panel hearing with the following witnesses:

The Subcommittee will consider the impact of the Dodd-Frank Act, actions of the Financial Stability Oversight Council and the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision, and other regulatory activities since 2010 on short-term financing in the U.S. capital markets, including repurchase agreements, money market funds, and securities financing.
