- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Bureau Guidance
- 5 Transparency Act".

1 SEC. 2. STANDARDS FOR ISSUING GUIDANCE.

2	Section 1022(b) of the Consumer Financial Protec-
3	tion Act of 2010 (12 U.S.C. 5512(b)) is amended by add-
4	ing at the end the following:
5	"(5) STANDARDS FOR ISSUING GUIDANCE.—In
6	issuing any guidance, the Bureau shall—
7	"(A) provide for a public notice and com-
8	ment period before issuing the guidance in final
9	form; and
10	"(B) when issuing guidance in final form,
11	make available to the public, including on the
12	website of the Bureau, all studies, data, and
13	other analysis relied on by the Bureau in pre-
14	paring and issuing such guidance.".
