Response to Question 5

Aon Benfield (under the Paragon Strategic Solutions Inc. name) were contracted by the U.S. Treasury Department in 2004 to create the processes and infrastructure needed to support Terrorism Risk Insurance Program (TRIP) in the event of a certified act of terrorism.

Our contract was renewed by the Department of the Treasury in August of 2008, with one-year incremental renewals through the end of 2013.

Our services for TRIP include:

- Systems for the receipt and processing of TRIP claims filed by insurers (my team would analyze those requests and make payment recommendations to the Treasury, with payments issued by Treasury)
- Systems for the calculation and invoicing of the monthly Federal Terrorism Policy Surcharges due Treasury from all U.S. Property and Casualty insurers (under specific circumstances),
- Statistical analyses (with ISO serving as our subcontractor), and
- General TRIP program support.
