The Division of Enforcement: Background and Activities

This hearing will discuss the specific portion of the SEC's FY 2018 and FY 2019 Budget request for the Division, discuss the Division's initiatives and activities and how this agenda is consistent with the SEC's Congressionally-mandated, tripartite mission to protect investors, to maintain fair, orderly, and efficient markets, and to facilitate capital formation. SEC Chairman Jay Clayton announced the appointment of Ms. Avakian and Mr. Peiken as Co-Directors of the Division of Enforcement on June 8, 2017.
