**Subject:** May 17, 2018, Housing and Insurance Subcommittee Hearing Entitled “An Overview of Homelessness in America”

The Subcommittee on Housing and Insurance will hold a hearing entitled “An Overview of Homelessness in America” on May 17, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building.

The Subcommittee will examine the state of homelessness in America, including current efforts to combat homelessness as well as any innovative solutions that Congress should consider to eradicate homelessness. Witnesses are expected to discuss the McKinney-Vento Act and the Interagency Council on Homelessness, the roles that each serve to reduce homelessness, and whether any legislative updates to either are necessary. Additionally, witnesses will discuss issues regarding veteran, youth, and any other populations affected by homelessness.
