1           *Resolved* that pursuant to clause 2(m) of Rule XI of the House, the Subcommittee  
2 authorizes the issuance of subpoenas to compel the testimony of Mr. Ali Naraghi, an employee  
3 of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB), and Mr. Kevin Williams, a former CFPB  
4 employee, on matters relating to the Subcommittee's investigation into allegations of  
5 discrimination and retaliation at the CFPB and related matters, including the operations of the  
6 Office of Consumer Response and the Division of Supervision, Fair Lending and Enforcement.  
7 Such subpoenas shall be signed by the Chair of the full Committee.
