Subject: November 1, 2017, Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations hearing entitled “Examining the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery Program”

The Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations will hold a hearing entitled “Examining the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery Program” on Wednesday, November 1, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. in room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The following witness will testify:

- Ms. Helen Albert, Acting Inspector General, Office of the Inspector General, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

This hearing will examine the Office of Inspector General’s oversight of the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (“CDBG-DR”) program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”).

The Acting Inspector General will discuss problems with the current administration of the CDBG-DR program, identify potential solutions to those problems, and long term challenges to the orderly administration of the CDBG-DR program. The hearing will examine legislative and administrative solutions that both Congress and HUD can take to reduce and ultimately eliminate waste, fraud and abuse in the CDBG-DR program and enhance HUD’s accountability as to its allocation of appropriated CDBG-DR funds.
