## 3 SECTION 1. PRE-IPO RESEARCH STUDY.

4 (a) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Securities and Ex-5 change Commission shall conduct a study to evaluate the 6 issues affecting the ability of small issuers, including 7 emerging growth companies, to obtain research coverage  $\mathbf{2}$ 

before their initial public offering, including the impact on
 the availability of research coverage for such issuers due
 to each of the following:

4 (1) Securities and Exchange Commission rules.
5 (2) Registered national securities association
6 rules.

7 (3) State and Federal liability concerns.

- 8 (4) The 2003 Global Research Analyst Settle-9 ments.
- 10 (5) The Markets in Financial Instruments Di-11 rective.

(b) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 90 days
after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Securities
and Exchange Commission shall submit to Congress a report that includes—

- 16 (1) the results of the study required by sub-17 section (a); and
- (2) recommendations to assist small issuers, including emerging growth companies, to obtain research coverage before their initial public offering.
