

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 6367
OFFERED BY MR. CLEAVER OF MISSOURI**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE .

2 This Act may be cited as the “Armed Conflict Migra-
3 tion Act of 2023”.

**4 SEC. 2. UNITED STATES ADVOCACY IN THE INTER-
5 NATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS FOR FI-
6 NANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COUNTRIES THAT
7 RECEIVE AN INFLUX OF DISPLACED PER-
8 SONS STEMMING FROM THE ARMED CON-
9 FFLICT THAT HAS RESULTED FROM HAMAS’S
10 OCTOBER 2023 TERRORISM IN ISRAEL, TO BE
11 USED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID FOR THE DIS-
12 PLACED PERSONS.**

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
14 shall instruct the United States Executive Director at each
15 international financial institution (as defined in section
16 1701(c)(2) of the International Financial Institutions Act
17 (22 U.S.C. 262r(c)(2))) to use the voice, vote, and influ-
18 ence of the United States to support the provision of fi-

1 nancial assistance to countries that receive an influx of
2 civilian, non-combatant displaced persons stemming from
3 the armed conflict that has resulted from Hamas's Octo-
4 ber 2023 terrorism in Israel, to be used for humanitarian
5 aid for the displaced persons, provided that such persons
6 are not arbitrarily deprived of the ability to reenter the
7 place from which they were displaced, consistent with 999
8 U.N.T.S. 171, and provided that the country is not a state
9 sponsor of terrorism.

10 (b) SUNSET.—This section shall cease to have any
11 force or effect on the earlier of—

12 (1) the date that is 7 years after the date of en-
13 actment of this section;

14 (2) the date on which the Secretary of the
15 Treasury certifies to the Committee on Financial
16 Services of the House of Representatives and the
17 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs
18 of the Senate that the requirement under subsection
19 (a) is not in the national interest of the United
20 States; and

21 (3) the date on which the Secretary of the
22 Treasury certifies to the Committee on Financial
23 Services of the House of Representatives and the
24 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs
25 of the Senate that the armed conflict that has re-

1 sulted from Hamas's October 2023 terrorism in
2 Israel has ceased to be a cause of an influx of civil-
3 ian, non-combatant displaced persons to other coun-
4 tries.
