## Amendment to H.R. 861 Offered by M\_.

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

## 1 SEC. 4. NOTIFICATION TO NSP GRANTEES REQUIRED.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the 3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Hous-4 ing and Urban Development shall determine the approxi-5 mate number of jobs that will be lost in the district of 6 each Member of Congress as a result of the rescission and 7 termination of funding under sections 2 and 3 and provide 8 such number to each such Member.

9 (b) NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 30 days after the
10 Secretary has made a determination under subsection (a),
11 the Secretary shall inform each entity (as defined in sub12 section (c))—

13 (1) that the program has been terminated;

(2) of the approximate number of jobs that the
Secretary has determined, under subsection (a), will
be lost as a result of rescission and termination of
funding under sections 2 and 3;

18 (3) of the name and contact information of
19 such entity's Member of Congress that represents its
20 district; and

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(4) that such entity should contact such Mem ber of Congress directly for assistance in mitigating
 foreclosed properties.

4 (c) ENTITY DEFINED.—The term "entity" means 5 any nonprofit, government, or other organization that—

6 (1) received or was scheduled to receive funding
7 pursuant to section 2301 of the Housing and Eco8 nomic Recovery Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–289;
9 122 Stat. 2850) or title XII of division A of the
10 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
11 (Public Law 111–5; 123 Stat. 218) through the
12 Neighborhood Stabilization Program; and

(2) as a result of the rescission and termination
of such funding under sections 2 and 3, will have
such funding rescinded or withheld.

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
