The Committee on Financial Services will hold a hearing on "Preserving Consumer Choice and Financial Independence" at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, March 18, 2015, in Room HVC-210 of the Capitol Visitors Center. This will be a one-panel hearing with the following witnesses:

This hearing will examine the impact of rising compliance costs brought on by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (P.L. 111-203) on consumers, community financial institutions, and the U.S. economy. In particular, the Committee looks to explore whether products or services are no longer being offered to consumers because of agency actions, and the impact on consumers if they no longer have access to specific products or services. This hearing will also provide Members with an opportunity to hear from industry stakeholders about how the current regulatory environment is affecting their ability to provide services to their customers and examine proposals to afford community financial institutions relief from unduly burdensome or unnecessary statutory or regulatory mandates.

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
